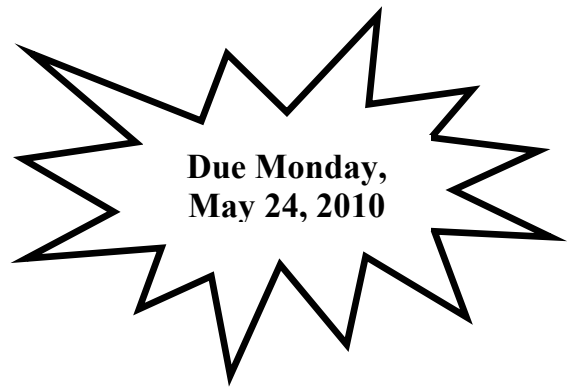


## Financial Aid Forms

Dear Prospective Parents,

Enclosed are the 2010-2011 Community Student Aid Form, Instruction Sheet, and Checklist. This packet is sent to all current and prospective families and is also available on the MJDS website: [www.mjds.org](http://www.mjds.org).

**If you would like to request a reduction in tuition of any kind for 2010-2011, submit your completed Community Student Aid Form (scholarship form) and all supporting documentation no later than Monday, May 24, 2010** to MJDS Scholarship, Attn: Christy Horn, P.O. Box 170273, Milwaukee, WI 53217.

All families requesting tuition support must submit a Community Student Aid Form – whether the request is for a community scholarship or an MJDS sliding scale reduction.

All information you provide with your application is treated with the highest confidentiality. The Day Schools Grant Allocation Committee (DSGAC) is organized by the Coalition for Jewish Learning (CJL) and is not associated with MJDS or the other day schools. The DSGAC receives your application, supporting documentation and tax returns labeled with a number only -- not your name. They do not receive any personal data. The DSGAC will only accept an application if you furnish **all** necessary information as stated on the Instruction Sheet for Applicants and the Application Checklist.

If your financial situation changes **after** you submit your application, immediately inform me in writing so I can forward the new information to the DSGAC. The committee will change its initial decision only if there is a change in circumstances.

The DSGAC assists with tuition only. Other school fees, such as transportation costs, programming fees, technology fees, food costs, and parent fundraising responsibilities are not part of the tuition scholarship process.

Applications received after the May 24, 2010 deadline may be too late for consideration. **Parents who miss the deadline for Community Student Aid may not be eligible for any tuition support through the MJDS sliding scale.** Therefore, it is crucial that you return your scholarship forms as soon as possible.
